<u>Lateness</u>

It may seem like 10 minutes isn't really that much, but a child who is 'only' 10 minutes late every day will miss 30 hours of school time that year. If a child is 10 minutes late getting to school, it is more like 20 minutes until they are actually learning. The impact on the class as a whole is even larger. If two children are late, one by 5 minutes and one by 10 minutes, then the whole class has to wait for them to settle and often the whole day's timetable is knocked backwards meaning the whole class miss out on something.

To help tackle the issue of lateness we have introduced a 'lateness letter' which will be sent home to parents at the end of each week. This will help us track families that are often late and allow us to offer appropriate support.
