A very warm welcome back to all our families and a very special welcome to all our new families, I hope you have all enjoyed the summer.

Over the next few days, you should receive a more detailed year group/class newsletter regarding PE days, book changes etc, but some general information that may be of interest to you includes:

Myself and our Assistant Headteachers, Mrs Clifton (EYFS lead), Mrs Smith (KS1 lead) and Mr Richardson (KS2 lead) are available should you need to talk about something that your child's class teacher cannot assist with. I can be found on the Reception Cloakroom door alongside Mrs Hall (School Business Manager) every morning for a quick word. Mrs Adams (Special Needs Coordinator) is out of class Monday and Tuesday and is happy to meet with any parents that feel they require further information or support. If you need support around a safeguarding issue myself and Mrs Smith are the safeguarding leads in school.

Our Nurture Team, Mrs Hodge (Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday) Mrs Burton (Thursday and Friday) are available throughout the school day to support any issues you would like to discuss, no matter how small. You can catch them for a quick word before or after school on the playground or make an appointment through the school office.

School uniform details can be found on our school website, including PE kit. Please support your child to ensure they have the correct uniform at all times, please label EVERYTHING, if there is no name, we find it very difficult to get it back to you. Children can come to school in their PE kits on their 'long PE day', this must adhere to our uniform policy, football kits are not acceptable. On none PE days children are expected in full uniform with school shoes, no trainers. Hair accessories are considered part of the uniform and should be small, have a practical purpose and in keeping with school colours please.

Parking is an ongoing issue for the vast majority of schools across the country and ours is no different. If you must drive to school please consider the whole school community, not just your own needs and your own children. We sit on a very busy bus route and parking a few minutes' walk away rather than trying to get close to the school gate may just save a child's life. We do encourage parking wardens to ticket parents that have parked inappropriately around the school. If you see an issue with parking, pictures you take can be sent to the local police team to help with this ongoing issue.

As always, we are offering an open-door policy, if you have any questions, concerns or comments your class teacher should always be your first point of contact.

It is lovely to have all the children back in school, they have all settled in well.
