Nature of support 2012/13

- Additional 2 and a half hours for lunchtime supervision in Foundation Stage 1
- Support the delivery of a range of Wave 2 and Wave 3 targeted interventions. (12.75 hours ATA and 4.5 hours GTA per week)
- To train staff in the delivery of the phonics programme
- Development for a whole school library
- Ensure that underachieving pupils (those who left KS1 at level 2C) or below make good progress and close the gap with their peers
- Provide extra support to enable pupils in Year 5 and 6 to achieve Level 4 in numeracy and literacy

Curriculum focus of PPG spending 2012/1013

- Foundation Stage pupils supported on an individual basis to improve phonics knowledge and key word recognition
- Key Stage 1 and 2 supported their progress in reading and writing
- Support pupil phonic knowledge through sound training
- Reading books enhance and enthuse readers across school and raise attainment and achievement of boys
- Reading club set up for under achieving boy readers

Measuring the proposed impact of PPG spending

Key Stage 1-

- Reading- Children made on average 4.5 APS progress.
- Writing- Children made on average 4.2 APS progress.
- Maths- Children made on average 4.6 APS progress.

Key Stage 2 –

- Reading- Children made on average 3 APS progress.
- Writing- Children made on average 2.9 APS progress.
- Maths- Children made on average 3 APS progress.
